A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST READING,  
BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPOINTING A BUILDING  
CODE OFFICIAL, ASSISTANT ZONING OFFICER AND  
ASSISTANT BUILDING INSPECTOR FOR THE BOROUGH OF  
WEST READING

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of West Reading, Berks County, Pennsylvania (the "Borough") has determined that it requires additional coverage to conduct inspections and for ordinance and code enforcement, and the issuance of permits; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough, to maintain such additional coverage, desires to appoint an individual qualified under applicable Pennsylvania law to act as a Building Code Official, Assistant Zoning Officer, and Assistant Building Inspector, to enforce the provisions of all Borough Codes and Ordinances, including but not limited to the Zoning Ordinance and building and construction codes, and granting said appointees and their designated employees, the power to issue citations for the violation of such codes and ordinances on behalf of the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of West Reading, and it is hereby RESOLVED AND ENACTED the Borough appoints the following:

Section 1.     Appointments. The following individual is appointed as follows:

- a)     Chad T. Moyer to serve as the Building Code Official for the Borough; and
- b)     Chad T. Moyer to serve as the and Assistant Zoning Officer for the Borough; and,
- c)     Chad T. Moyer to serve as the Assistant Building Inspector.

Section 2.     Powers. The above-referenced individual is appointed to enforce the provisions of all applicable Borough Codes and Ordinances. This appointment shall include the power to inspect, issue permits, enforce, and issue citations and take other authorized legal action for the violation of such applicable codes and ordinances on behalf of the Borough.

Section 3.     Revocation of Appointment. The above-referenced appointment is revocable by Council at any time.

Section 4. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Resolution is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Resolution. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 5. Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts of ordinances or resolutions which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with the provisions hereof.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.
