- 306 Sycamore this property is a short sale. There are some issues with the exterior that should be checked by Codes.

- 301 Penn The office suite is still available for lease.
- 402 Penn Has been leased to H2O 4 Life Wellness Center.
- 520 Penn Has been leased as a barbershop.

Old & New Business

- 603 Penn Fred Astaire Dance Studio The property is currently being used as a church
 which is only permitted in the Central Business District as a 'special exception'. Steps
 will be taken to inform the owner of the property that this type of use is not permitted
 by right.
- Strategic Planning A comprehensive list needs to be developed that provides a plan for
 future economic development in the Borough. This can include design standards,
 architectural standards, parking, signs etc. Once a list is developed, it can be taken to
 Council for their adoption. Mr. Wert asked that everyone email him within the next
